the hindenburg line or siegfriedstellung achieved almost mythical status in the minds of the british public the strongest defence system the world had then seen scientifically designed by fortification experts with only one aim to keep at bay the british army so pleased and delighted were the british that church bells were rung when the line was pierced at cambrai in november 1917 the new wonder weapon the tank had shown itself to be capable of great deeds and british generals were seen to be capable of showing the germans what tommy could do when properly organised the initial elation was followed by disappointment as the germans fought back and the hindenburg defences were retaken when the germans used defence in depth and elastic defence both new concepts to the british who were to learn from their mistakes the british were to witness triumph and joy again when towards the end of the great war the hindenburg line was to be broken by men from the midlands this book examines the reasons for the german s decision to fall back to a strong defence line while their navy starved britain into submission and the burnt earth policy of devastation in the area evacuated the design and layout of the hindenburg line and the battles for its possession in 1917 and 1918 are given with numerous maps covering different sectors and the struggles for each village and farm together with the part played by many british regiments the maps contain information on how to find all remaining vestiges of both german and british defences in the region most of which are rarely visited and many of which have not been seen by british eyes for many years no book since the great war has examined this area in such detail nor has any single account contained so much for the battlefield visitor to see the sites of individual acts of bravery including the winning of many victoria crosses are featured and existing locations of battle lines headquarters artillery observation and machine gun posts are also included together with an absorbing narrative which also guides the armchair reader

about three quarters of a century has passed since the australians faced mauser and pom pom fire and suffered the ravages of disease in south africa sadly the story of the australian contribution in the boer war is not well known this is surprising because no less than 16 175 enlisted men embarked to fight in south africa it was the first significant force to leave australia there were also many who either worked or paid a passage to the front the south african regiments raised in natal and cape colony all contained them many australian refugees from paul kruger s republic also served in the colonial regiments altogether the number of fighting australians must have been 20 000 or more in fact australians seem to have taken part in almost every major engagement for some fought with british regular units from the manner in which australians bore themselves in a highly mobile campaign in a country similar to their own they earned a reputation second to none as mounted infantry and scouts after such a lapse of time any worthwhile account of their record in the campaign over the best part of three years would hardly be possible but for the preservation in the newspapers of the day of soldiers letters from the front the exploits and comments told in the words of the men who were there on veldt and kopje fitted into the story of a moving campaign form the basis of this history

the boer artillery units they were the only boer troops to wear uniforms were organized on a full time basis and were equipped with excellent german field pieces the british artillery soon found itself out gunned and out ranged some british officers however were capable of adapting to the new conditions in south africa royal naval vessels anchored off the cape had powerful long range cannons it was decided to try bringing these guns ashore and mounting them on improvised carriages for field use naval infantry brigades had served in some previous campaigns and proved capable of accompanying the army as gun crews their straw hats and naval leggings identifiable in many wartime photographs although they were depicted in many wartime drawings and photographs no serious study of the naval artillery has ever been done tony bridgland has spent many years researching the topic and has produced a study of the technical problems involved in this unique operation as well as a colourful narrative of naval personnel pressed into hazardous service far from the sea

this book explores the challenges of combating terrorism from a policing perspective using the example of the royal ulster constabulary gc ruc in northern ireland the ruc was in the frontline of counter terrorism work for thirty years of conflict during which time it also provided a normal policing service to the public however combating a protracted and vicious terrorist campaign exacted a heavy price on the force importantly the book addresses a seriously under researched theme in terrorism studies namely the impact of terrorism on members of the security forces accordingly the book examines how officers have been affected by the conflict as terrorists adopted a strategy which targeted them both on and off duty this resulted in a high percentage of officers being killed whilst off duty sometimes in the company of their wives and children the experience of officers wives is also documented thus highlighting the familial impact of terrorism generally speaking the victims of terrorist attacks have received scant scholarly attention which has resulted in victims experiences being little understood this piece of work casts a specific and unique light on the nature of victimhood as it has been experienced by members of this branch of the security forces in northern ireland
