perhaps the foremost social analyst and journalist on cuban affairs carlos alberto montaner has written a definitive study of the cuban regime from the vantage point of the cuban dictator this is not simply a history of cuban communism but rather a personal history of its leader fidel castro montaner s extraordinary knowledge of the country and its politics prevents the work from becoming a psychiatric examination from afar indeed what personal irrationalities exist are seen as built into the fabric of the regime itself and not simply as a personality aberration fidel castro and the cuban revolution is not an apologia for past united states involvement in cuban affairs the author is severe in his judgments of such participation nor is he sparing in his sense of the betrayal of the original purposes of the revolution of 1959 manifested in the character and policies of fidel castro as the work progresses from a study of the victims to a study of the beneficiaries of the cuban revolution it leaves the reader with a deep sense of the tragedy of a revolution betrayed but not one that could have easily been avoided montaner is an exile like the great alexander Herzen before him his decision to live in europe was made by choice not of necessity he sees his role as critical analyst not as restoring the status quo ante a most valuable aspect of this book is its intimate reevaluation of fulgencio batista whatever the reader s judgment of montaner s work no one can read it and be dismissive of the effort it is a work of intimacy even though written in exile and hence must be viewed as an important effort to understand the character of the man and regime who have changed the course of cuban history in our times

bedroom politics revolution and regicide is a biographical snapshot of the monarchs of france and russia louis xvi and nicholas ii respectively as well as their wives marie antoinette and alexandra feodorovna it is also a political study of the socio economic climates in france and russia at the time of the individual revolutions both king louis and tsar nicholas were benevolent masters but the frustrations from the previous regimes crept into their rules and led to a forced change in the political systems the main problem however always seemed to be the wives marie antoinette and alexandra were often the objects if not scapegoats of the people's rage first the queens were both regarded as outsiders german women and they were thought to be poor influences on their husbands in reality their influence came late in the reigns almost at the point when revolution was inevitable in addition to being outsiders their personalities have also been severely judged the queen of france was seen as a frivolous spendthrift while the tsarina was believed to be cold and selfish for the most part the public was right about marie antoinette's self indulgences but were wrong about alexandra's coldness she was simply private and reserved the extravagances of the french royals and the aloofness of the russian sovereigns spurred the subjects into violent resistance which resulted in the overthrow of the existing orders unfortunately the monarchs in both countries were consistently slow to respond to the impending rebellions and paid for the weak wills with their lives and the lives of their families

social revolutions it gives us books paintings public monuments even tv shows written by 164 american and european specialists the essays are introduced by date and arranged in chronological order but here ends the book s resemblance to the usual history of literature each date is followed by a headline evoking an event that indicates the chronological point of departure usually the event is literary the publication of an original work a journal a translation the first performance of a play the death of an author but some events are literary only in terms of their repercussions and resonances essays devoted to a genre exist alongside essays devoted to one book institutions are presented side by side with literary movements and large surveys appear next to detailed discussions of specific landmarks no article is limited to the life and works of a single author proust for example appears through various lenses fleetingly in 1701 apropos of antoine galland s translation of the thousand and one nights in 1898 in connection with the dreyfus affair in 1905 on the occasion of the law on the separation of church and state in 1911 in relation to gide and their different treatments of homosexuality and at his death in 1922 without attempting to cover every author work and cultural development since the serments de strasbourg in 842 this history succeeds in being both informative and critical about the more than 1 000 years it describes the contributors offer us a chance to appreciate not only french culture but also the major critical positions in literary studies today a new history of french literature will be essential reading for all engaged in the study of french culture and for all who are interested in it it is an authoritative lively and readable volume

camille desmoulins a journalist writing under the montagnard regime of 1793 94 remarked that france s government had replaced the language of democracy with the cold poison of fear which paralyzed thought in the bottom of people s souls and prevented it from pouring forth at the tribunal or in writing how this happened how the reign of terror reached even into the realms of thought and language is the subject of caroline weber s book a revealing look into the paradoxical embargo on free expression that underpinned the robespierrists self proclaimed despotism of liberty during the french revolution weber examines jean jacques rousseau s and the robespierrists articulation of a series of initiatives designed to curtail and control the dissemination of alternative political and philosophical messages in the republic here weber underscores the internal contradictions and limitations of an enterprise that promised universal freedom while oppressing particularism and that railed against the very language that it was compelled to adopt as a principal political tool the book then focuses on two eloquent contemporary critics of this phenomenon desmoulins and the marquis de sade the infamous libertine author weber demonstrates how desmoulins reconfigured the montagnard regime s rhetoric to conjure up a political system based on tolerance not terror and how sade deftly parodied the robespierrists brutality and hypocrisy proposing a republic based on the ruthless elimination of dissident voices and on the unabashed celebration of despotism and bloodshed a balanced account of how the discourse of totality actually restricted particular freedoms in the wake of the french revolution this book provides a highly original and timely exposition of the political uses of rhetoric and of the links between language and power
