weapons designs and nuclear enrichment equipment to libya iran and north korea his colleagues have held discussions with al qaeda representatives ayman al zawahiri number two in the al qaeda chain of command claims that the terrorist organization has several suitcase a bombs from the former soviet union it appears clear to many that iran has a desire to develop nuclear weapons syria still has a chemical weapons program north korea s wmd profile has escalated as avoiding the abyss so convincingly demonstrates much has been accomplished since the counterproliferation initiative was launched but much work still lies ahead it is an important story for every american
