*The Adventures of Pinocchio, a Marionette* 1922 introduction of marionette making a marionette is a puppet made of strings and often has movable parts they are used to perform plays and are often used in children s theater today we will be learning how to make a marionette a marionette can be made from various materials but the most common are wood and string wood is the most common material because it is affordable and easy to work with string is often used because it is strong and can be manipulated easily before you start making a marionette you must gather the materials you will need these materials include a wood frame strings and a

puppet head the wood frame can be made from various materials but the most common are cardboard and wood the cardboard is cut into a shape that will fit inside the wood frame and the wood is then glued to the cardboard the puppet head can be made from various materials but the most common are plastic and rubber the plastic is cut into a shape that will fit on the puppet head and the rubber is then glued to the plastic once you have gathered the materials you can start making your marionette the first step is to cut the strings you will need enough strings to cover the wood frame and puppet head the length of the strings will depend on the size of the marionette the next step is to attach the strings to the puppet head and the wood frame you will need to tie the strings in a knot to secure them once the strings are attached you can start moving the puppet you will need to use your hands and the strings to move the puppet you must use the strings to move the puppet in the desired direction

**Conservation of a Marionette Attributed to Tony Sarg** 2020 in this fascinating and colorful book researcher and performer john mccormick focuses on the marionette world of victorian britain between its heyday after 1860 and its waning years from 1895 to 1914 situating the rich and diverse puppet theatre in the context of entertainment culture he explores both the aesthetics of these dancing dolls and their sociocultural significance in their life and time the history of marionette performances is interwoven with live actor performances and with the entire gamut of annual fairs portable and permanent theatres music halls magic lantern shows waxworks panoramas and sideshows mccormick has drawn upon advertisements in the era an entertainment paper between the 1860s and world war i and articles in the world s fair a paper for showpeople in the first fifty years of the twentieth century as well as interviews with descendants of the marionette showpeople and close examinations of many of the surviving puppets mccormick begins his study with an exploration of the victorian marionette theatre in the context of other theatrical events of the day with proprietors and puppeteers and with the venues where they performed he further examines the marionette s position as an actor not quite human but imitating humans closely enough to be considered empathetic the ways that physical attributes were created with wood paint and cloth and the dramas and melodramas that the dolls performed a discussion of the trick figures and specialized acts that each company possessed as well as an exploration of the theatre s staging lighting and costuming follows in later chapters mccormick concludes with a description of the last days of marionette theatre in the wake of changing audience expectations and the increasing popularity of moving pictures this highly enjoyable and readable study often illuminated by intriguing anecdotes such as that of the armenian photographer who fell in love with and abducted the holden company s cinderella marionette in 1881 will appeal to everyone fascinated by the magic of nineteenth century theatre many of whom will discover how much the marionette could contribute to that magic

Pinocchio 1966 the adventures of pinocchio is a novel for children by italian author carlo collodi written in pescia the first half was originally a serial in 1881 and 1882 and then later completed as a book for children in february 1883 it is about the mischievous adventures of an animated marionette named pinocchio and his father a poor woodcarver named geppetto it is considered a canonical piece of children s literature and has inspired hundreds of new editions stage plays merchandising and movies such as walt disney s iconic animated version and commonplace ideas such as a liar s long nose according to extensive research done by

the fondazione nazionale carlo collodi in late 1990s and based on unesco sources it has been adapted in over 240 languages worldwide that makes it among the most translated and widely read books ever written the adventures of pinocchio is a story about an animated puppet boys who turn into donkeys and other fairy tale devices the setting of the story is the tuscan area of italy it was a unique literary marriage of genres for its time the story s italian language is peppered with florentine dialect features such as the protagonist s florentine name in the 1850s collodi began to have a variety of both fiction and non fiction books published once he translated some french fairy tales so well that he was asked whether he would like to write some of his own in 1881 he sent a short episode in the life of a wooden puppet to a friend who edited a newspaper in rome wondering whether the editor would be interested in publishing this bit of foolishness in his children s section the editor did and the children loved it the adventures of pinocchio were serialized in the paper in 1881 2 and then published in 1883 with huge success in the original serialized version pinocchio dies a gruesome death hanged for his innumerable faults at the end of chapter 15 at the request of his editor collodi added chapters 16 36 in which the fairy with turquoise hair or blue fairy as the disney version names her rescues pinocchio and eventually transforms him into a real boy when he acquires a deeper understanding of himself making the story more suitable for children in the second half of the book the maternal figure of the blue haired fairy is the dominant character versus the paternal figure of geppetto in the first part children s literature was a new idea in collodi s time an innovation in the 19th century thus in content and style it was new and modern opening the way to many writers of the following century
